OEMHS Updates - Tina Labov

- We've recently completed an update to the County Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) and are working through the process of getting that through to County Council Approval
- We just participated in the Med Star Montgomery table top exercise and are currently revamping our Training and Exercise calendar for our internal emergency management group
- We are in the process of scoring the Continuity of Operations Plans for our county departments.
- We are working closely with the University of Maryland and the Maryland Department of Emergency Management on the implementation of a state Mesonet network which will provide more local weather data to Montgomery County and the state of Maryland to support weather events.
- We have hired a Climate Adaptation Program Manager and a Hydrologist to help the office and the County move forward on our climate action plan initiatives. Currently, our Climate adaptation program manager, mara parker is working on resiliency hubs best practices to implement in Montgomery County. Our hydrologist, Paramjit has been engaged in the County's flood study and is performing localized analyses in the County.
- We are working with several County departments on emergency preparedness training and safety, and notifications.
- In addition to our community outreach program, we are planning a school safety seminar for MCPS and local private schools to engage them in best practices in school safety.
- We have a draft of the updated Hazard Mitigation Plan which is currently under state review at the Maryland Department of Emergency Management.
