WorkYears DESCRIPTION

This project provides a new local park on a 25-acre tract of undeveloped parkland on Glen Road in Potomac. Facilities will include a regulation soccer/football field with spectator areas, a single basketball/multi-use court, a single grass volleyball court, a playground, asphalt loop path and pedestrian connections, central seating and entrance feature, picnic table areas, gazebo, 70 space parking area, portable toilets, bioretention stormwater management facilities, landscaping, and other miscellaneous amenities. Design is scheduled in FY10, with construction in FY11-FY13.

JUSTIFICATION

This new park was proposed in the Potomac Subregion Master Plan approved and adopted in 2002. The 1998 Park, Recreation and Open Space Master Plan identified the Travilah planning area as having some of the highest unmet recreational needs in the County, specifically identifying the need for ballfields, basketball courts, and playgrounds in this planning area. The Montgomery County Planning Board approved the park facility plan on September 8, 2005. Greenbriar will provide many new facilities estimated as needed by the 2005 Land Preservation, Parks and Recreation Plan, specifically a playground, basketball court and a new soccer field. This park is essential as it is one of the few locations where new fields in the area can be placed. The path will provide pedestrian access to the schools and community.

Facility plan approved by the Montgomery County Planning Board September 8, 2005. Potomac Subregion Master Plan approved and adopted in 2002.

FISCAL NOTE

In 2003, the Commission received a \$300,000 donation in lieu of land from William Rickman to provide for a regulation soccer field somewhere in the Potomac Subregion.
