Description

Enrollment projections at Judith Resnik Elementary School reflect a need for an addition. Judith Resnik Elementary School has a program capacity for 503 students. Enrollment is expected to reach 655 students by the 2019-2020 school year. A feasibility study was conducted in FY 2013 to determine the cost and scope of the project. While the planning funds remain on the schedule requested by the Board of Education, due to fiscal constraints, the construction funds were programmed one year later in the approved FY2015-2020 CIP. The Board of Education's requested FY2015-2020 Amended CIP reinstated the construction schedule previously requested by the Board. Due to fiscal constraints, the County Council did not approved the Board's request. An FY 2017 appropriation will be requested for planning funds. This project is scheduled to be completed by August 2020.
