PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Wheaton Woods Elementary School was built in 1952 and renovated in 1976. Scheduling of this modernization is consistent with the MCPS long-range plans to renew aging facilities on a rational and periodic basis. The modernization will include an addition to this facility due to projected enrollment growth. Due to fiscal constraints, the modernization schedule for elementary, middle, and high schools was delayed. An FY 2013 appropriation was approved for planning funds. Due to fiscal constraints, the Board of Education's Requested FY 2015-2020 CIP includes a one-year delay for elementary school revitalizations/expansions. Due to fiscal constraints, the approved FY2015-2020 CIP includes an additional one year delay beyond the Board's request. The Board of Education's requested FY2015-2020 Amended CIP reinstated the construction schedule previously requested by the Board. The County Council approved the Board's request. An FY 2016 appropriation was approved for construction funds. An FY 2017 appropriation was approved to complete this project. This project is now scheduled to be completed August 2017.
