An FY 2011 appropriation was approved to continue this program to maintain code compliance and life-cycle equipment replacement. An FY 2012 appropriation was approved to continue this level of effort project. An FY 2013 appropriation was approved to maintain life safety code compliance and equipment life-cycle replacements at MCPS facilities systemwide. An FY 2014 appropriation was approved to continue this project. An FY 2015 appropriation was approved to continue this level of effort project and maintain life safety code compliance through equipment replacement such as fire alarm systems that will be over 20 years old and will have exceeded their anticipated life-cycle. An FY 2016 appropriation was approved to continue this level of effort project. An FY 2017 appropriation was approved to continue this level of effort project as well as address code compliance issues related to the storage of flammable materials at schools systemwide.
