SUBJECT: Approval of the FY 2022 Aggregate Capital Budget for Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission Bonds

Background

- 1. Section 305 of the County Charter requires the affirmative vote of at least 7 Councilmembers to approve an aggregate capital budget if that budget exceeds the adopted spending affordability guidelines then in effect.
- 2. Section 20-56 of the County Code requires the Council to set guidelines for the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission bonds by resolution no later than the first Tuesday in October in each odd-numbered calendar year. This section also permits the Council to revise the guidelines to reflect a significant change in conditions by the first Tuesday in February.
- 3. On October 1, 2019, the Council adopted guidelines for the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission bonds allowing no more than \$8.0 million to be planned for expenditure in FY 2021, no more than \$8.0 million to be planned for expenditure in FY 2022, and no more than \$42.7 million to be planned for expenditure during the 6-year period from FY 2021 through FY 2026.
- 4. On February 4, 2020, the Council confirmed the guidelines for the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission bonds set on October 1, 2019.
- 5. On February 2, 2021, the Council confirmed the guidelines for the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission bonds set on October 1, 2019.

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:

The Council estimates that the amount of Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission bonds planned for expenditure does not exceed the guidelines adopted on

October 1, 2019 and confirmed on February 4, 2020 and February 2, 2021. Seven affirmative votes are not required for the approval of the aggregate capital budget because the guidelines in effect are not exceeded.
