SUBJECT: <u>Approval of FY 2023-2028 Capital Improvements Program of the Housing</u> <u>Opportunities Commission, and Approval of and Appropriation for the FY 2023</u> <u>Capital Budget</u>

Background

- 1. In a spirit of cooperation, the Housing Opportunities Commission sent to the County Executive a 6-year Capital Improvements Program (CIP) for the Housing Opportunities Commission.
- 2. Section 302 of the County Charter requires the Executive to send to the County Council by January 15 (or the next business day if it falls on a weekend/holiday) in each even-numbered calendar year a 6-year CIP, which the Executive did on January 18, 2022 for the 6-year period FY 2023-2028. Section 302 requires the affirmative vote of at least 5 Councilmembers to approve or modify the Executive's Recommended CIP. After the Council approves a CIP, Section 302 permits the Council to amend it at any time with the affirmative vote of at least 6 Councilmembers.
- 3. Section 303 of the Charter requires the Executive to send to the Council by January 15 (or the next business day if it falls on a weekend/holiday) in each year a recommended Capital Budget, which the Executive did on January 18, 2022 for FY 2023.
- 4. As required by Section 304 of the County Charter, the Council held public hearings on the FY 2023-2028 Capital Improvements Program and the FY 2023 Capital Budget.

<u>Action</u>

The Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution for the Housing Opportunities Commission:

- 1. For FY 2023, the Council approves the projects and authorizes the amounts by project, which are shown in Part I.
- 2. The Council reauthorizes the authorizations made in prior years for all capital projects:
 - a) except as specifically reflected elsewhere in this resolution;
 - b) in the amounts and for the purposes specified in the approved CIP for FY 2023-2028; and
 - c) to the extent that those authorizations are not expended or encumbered.
- 3. The Council approves the close out of the projects in Part III.
- 4. If a sign recognizing the contribution of any Federal, State, or local government or agency is displayed at any project for which funds are appropriated in this resolution, as a condition of spending those funds each sign must also expressly recognize the contribution of the County and the County's taxpayers.
