PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Enrollment projections at S. Christa McAuliffe Elementary School reflect a need for an addition. S. Christa McAuliffe Elementary School has a program capacity for 533 students. Enrollment is expected to reach 697 students by the 2019-2020 school year. A

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feasibility study was conducted in FY 2013 to determine the cost and scope of the project. While the planning funds remain on the schedule requested by the Board of Education, due to fiscal constraints, the construction funds were programmed one year later in the approved FY 2015-2020 CIP. The Board of Education's requested FY 2015-2020 Amended CIP reinstated the construction schedule previously requested by the Board. Due to fiscal constraints, the County Council did not approve the Board's request. Based on new enrollment projections, this school has one of the highest space deficits of approved projects in the Amended FY2015-2020 CIP. Therefore, the Board of Education, in the FY 2017-2022 CIP, accelerated this project one year. An FY 2017 appropriation was approved for planning funds. An FY 2018 appropriation was approved to complete this project. This project is scheduled to be completed by September 2019. FY20 reduction to recognize cost savings.
