Please accept this leter as an Exemption Statement for the subject development, in accordance with the 2020-2024 Growth and infrastructure Policy and the 2023 Local Area Transportation Review (LATR) Guidelines. The site is located at 7210 Bradley Boulevard, Bethesda, MD and is currently developed with an Veterinary Office/Hospital and Single Family Residence. The site is located within the Bethesda-Chevy Chase Transportation Policy Area.

Our client, Bradley Hills Animal Hospital, has filed a Conditional Use request to continue the use of the property as a Veterinary Office/Hospital, as it has been operating since the late 1970's. The existing use has operated pursuant to validly issued home occupation certificates, the most recent of which was issued on March 01, 2000. The existing building, site layout, and approved operations will remain unchanged as a result of this Application.

Although there is no new development proposed, our office conducted a trip generation analysis using the Institute of Transportation Engineers (ITE) Trip Generation Manual (11th Edition) in conjunction with Appendix Tables 1a and 1b of the 2023 LATR Guidelines. As shown in the attached Exhibit, the existing use generates a maximum of 8 AM peak hour and 8 PM peak hour person trips.

The LATR guidelines stipulate those projects generating less than 50 net new peak hour person, transit or non-motorized trips are exempt from LATR requirements.
