Dear Mr. Sampson,

I am the Contract Hearing Examiner assigned to hear the referenced case on Thursday, April 18, 2024.

In the Letter of Justification, Section VII, Anticipated Witness Testimony, you are listed as a potential witness. As you are counsel for the Applicant, please be informed that you cannot also be a witness for the Applicant.

Further, I wish to call your attention to the Transmission Facility Coordinating Group approval which the Applicant received on October 4, 2024. The application was accepted/certified on February 22, 2024, more than 90 days from the TFCG approval. Because the TFCG approval date cannot be more than 90 days prior to the application acceptance, any approval of the application issued by the hearing examiner will be conditioned on the Applicant obtaining an updated Transmission Facility Coordinating Group approval for the proposed use.

Last, please note that the Applicant's Statement of Justification states that the Applicant is requesting a setback reduction to a detached house from 300 feet to 188 feet from the nearest dwelling unit to the east. The the submitted Site Plan, however, does not show the setback distance from any dwelling unit, and does not indicate the applicable dwelling unit. The Staff Report, on the other hand, states that the pole's setback is "180 feet from the nearest existing dwelling to the south" (yet there does not appear to be a dwelling unit less than 300 feet to the south.) The Applicant will need to verify, by submitting a corrected site plan before or during the hearing, the actual setbacks and requested setback reductions along all property lines and from the nearest existing dwelling unit (which should be designated as such on the Site Plan).
