





- An **attempted residential burglary** occurred in the 10600 block of Weymouth Street on 4/21 at 7:34 a.m. No entry gained; nothing taken.


E1 Beat:




Suspect: Female, age unknown







- A **residential burglary** occurred in the 13300 block of Dovedale Way on 4/20 at 6 p.m. Forced entry; nothing taken.


Suspects: 3 Males, age unknown


