#### **CONSTRUCTION OF THE FOURTEENTH (14th) FLOOR COMMENCES**

**Project Status:** The project remains on-schedule for a May 30, 2020 substantial completion and is currently 62-percent complete. Interior work including mechanical, electrical, duct, sprinkler, and plumbing is underway on floors 1 through 7. The exterior sheathing is being installed on floors 3 through 7 (see photo). Windows are being installed on floors 3 & 4. Building occupation and tenant move-in is scheduled during summer 2020.

Electrical, mechanical, and sprinkler installation continues at Levels P1 and P0.



# **Utility Construction**

Pepco relocations are complete with exception of pole removal that will follow removal of the overhead Verizon lines.

# **Verizon Underground Work**

Verizon work nearly complete along Grandview Avenue. The utility poles along the west side of Grandview Ave will be removed within the next 2-weeks.

# **Utility Work**

1. Sanitary sewer work along Veirs Mill Road will continue this week. Sanitary sewer work will continue this week at night between the hours of 9pm and 5am and have little impact on traffic.

2. Storm drain installation will take place in Reedie Drive this week. Alternating one-way traffic will be managed by the Contractor.

#### **Town Plaza**

The Town Plaza will include an amphitheater, stage, lighting, art work, Wi-Fi, bio-retention areas, landscaping, and elevated walkways from the new Town Plaza to Georgia Ave (to the south) and to the WMATA tower connecting to the WMATA parking garage located on Veirs Mill Road.

Installation of storm drains and the start of foundation work for the bio-retention areas and elevated walkways will commence later this week.

- ✓ Plumbing, electrical, and mechanical installations continues on floors 1-6
- ✓ Exterior sheathing installation underway on floors 3 through 7.
- ✓ Application of blue-skin waterproofing underway on floors 3,4, & 5
- ✓ Bathroom mock-up nearly complete on the second floor
- Placement of concrete block, door frames, piping, sprinklers, and electrical in the garage on Levels P1 and P0 continues (P2, P3 and P4 complete)
- ✓ Sanitary sewer work in Veirs Mill Road (night work)
- ✓ Storm drain construction in Reedie Drive will require alternating one-way traffic.
- ✓ Offsite material fabrications underway
  - Stone
  - Misc. metals
  - Windows
  - Building skin
  - Chillers HVAC
  - Interior lights
- ✓ Town Plaza (South of Reedie Drive)
  - Excavation and haul-off complete
  - Rough grading complete
  - Installation of storm drain lines underway
  - Foundation units for bio-retention areas and elevated walkways will commence this week, weather permitting.
