

Adult Volunteer Opportunities

- **Dog Handler:** Dog Handlers are responsible for walking dogs, preparing and distributing enrichment items, cleaning runs and play areas as necessary.
- **Cat Handler:** Cat Handlers are responsible for socializing and providing enrichment to cats.
- **Small Animal Handler:** Small Animal Handlers are responsible for grooming the small animals and providing enrichment and other special activities.
- **Barn Attendant:** Barn Attendants are responsible for assisting with the socialization of animals and special projects as assigned. Barn Attendant responsibilities will depend on level of commitment, experience and interest.
- **Groomer:** Animal Groomers are responsible for brushing, bathing, trimming fur, etc. Animals deemed safe for grooming will be identified by animal handlers.
- **Behavior Assistant:** Behavior Assistants are responsible for the socialization, enrichment and training of animals, including other special activities.
- **Greeter:** Adoption Greeters are responsible for greeting prospective adopters, explaining the adoption process to them, and assisting them in filling out Meet Your Match surveys.
- **MYM Coordinator:** Meet Your Match (MYM) Coordinators are responsible for scoring prospective adopters Meet Your Match surveys in preparation to meet with an Adoption Counselor.
- **Adoption Visit Assistant:** Adoption Visit Assistants are responsible for transporting animals to and from the "Meet and Greet" rooms/visiting areas to meet potential adopters, as well as helping supervise adoption visits.
- **Special Event Assistant:** Special Events Assistants are responsible for assisting staff with the coordination of special events both on and off site.
