The BCC Conversation Club is an opportunity for non-native English speakers to practice speaking English. Volunteer facilitators provide a timely discussion topic each week as the basis for Conversation Club participants to share their experiences and their countries' culture.

We meet weekly on Wednesdays 11:00 AM to 12:30 PM between mid-September and the end of May. Our sixth year begins on September 16, 2015.

The Regional Services Center is located across the street from the Bethesda Metro station (Red Line Metro and bus). Participants who live near downtown Bethesda can walk to the Services Center. A public (pay) parking lot is downstairs in the building.

BCC Conversation Club meetings are free. The club is not a class with sequential lessons; thus, participants can attend as it suits their schedules.
