4. Discuss Budget for Spay/Neuter Program

7:55 p.m.

Jennifer Hughes expresses concerns that there was no budget for a spay/neuter program in the CE's FY24 Budget. Director Koenig suggested that J. Hughes and members submit a proposal either through OAS' FY24 Budget or apply for a Grant Enhancement Program now in time for the CE's FY24 Budget for their proposed Spay/Neuter Program. Vicky Thomas gave a presentation representing the Montgomery County Spay Neuter Initiative Program (MCSNIP). This coalition formed a year ago, of nonprofit animal welfare representatives led by MCC3/MCPAW to establish a dedicated low/no cost spay/neuter clinic for Montgomery County. Jennifer Hughes states annual costs for MCSNIP proposal would be \$250,000 to \$300,000.

Jennifer Hughes moves for a Motion that the Committee support, make recommendations, and submit a proposal for a no/low-cost spray neuter program for inclusive funding for said program to the County Executive to be added to the County's FY24 Budget. Beth Mullin seconded the motion. All members in favor - motion approved.
