 - 2) <u>Changes to grants process</u>: Carolyn gave an overview of the changes underway in the County grants making process. She noted that only \$118 million in County spending comes from Federal funds and one of the goals of the new grants process is to seek additional state and federal funding to support County programs and services. She

mentioned that small nonprofits can receive training and support from "Nonprofit Montgomery" and the incubator "Nonprofit Village"
