Public Comment Period Extended For Forest Glen Ireland Trail

(Silver Spring, Md.) — The public review and comment period for an Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis regarding portions of Ireland Trail has been extended to September 11, 2014. This will provide the community an additional 30 days to submit comments.

The EE/CA recommends an action to restrict the public from access to a portion of the Ireland Trail. The trail is a foot path located on Army property and has been used by the public for many years. This action will eliminate risks associated with exposure to potential hazards at areas located adjacent to the trail.
