

IN THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR MONTGOMERY COUNTY, MARYLAND

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

It is this 16th day of October, 2013, by the Circuit Court for Montgomery County, Maryland, hereby

ORDERED, that, when collateral security is ordered by the court in cash (e.g., "cash bail," "cash bond," "full cash, "all cash") to ensure the appearance of the defendant, as required by Maryland Rule 4-216(g)(4), the bond may be secured in any form authorized by Maryland Rule 4-217(e)(1), including cash, certified check or an encumbered parcel of real estate; and it is further


ORDERED, Criminal Procedure § 5-203(a)(3)(i), shall be enforced, which reads:

"Except as provided in subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, if an order setting "cash bail" or "cash bond" specifies that it may be posted by the defendant only, the "cash bail" or "cash bond" may be posted by the defendant, by an individual, or by a private surety, acting for the defendant, that holds a certificate of authority in the State."

and it is further

ORDERED, Criminal Procedure § 5-203(a)(3)(ii), shall be enforced, which reads:

"Unless otherwise ordered by the court, an order setting "cash bail" or "cash bond" for a failure to pay support under Title 10, Title 11, Title 12, or Title 13 of the Family Law Article may be posted by the defendant only."
