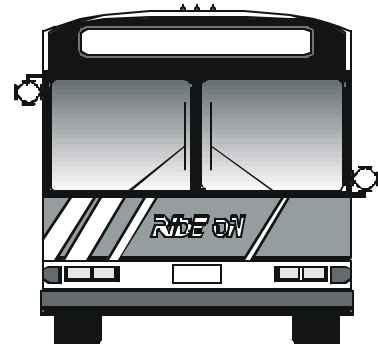


## Student Responsibilities...

### ***For your comfort, safety and use of Ride On:***

1. Board one at a time and allow the operator to READ the student pass or student identification card.
2. Refrain from playing, fighting, smoking, screaming, eating, drinking, and spitting.
3. The use of profanity, disruptive behavior or any item listed in #2, will result in the removal from the bus, confiscation of the pass and termination of participation in the Ride Free Program.
4. Allow seniors and disabled persons to occupy priority seating.
5. Use headphones when playing your radio and **set the volume at LOW.**
6. Passes or identification cards are NOT transferable. Do not give to adults or other individuals that are not in the school system.
7. Stay behind the safety line on the bus when you are standing.
8. Allow the operator to drive safely by not speaking with the operator while the bus is moving.
9. Take personal belongings with you when leaving the bus.
10. As a courtesy, hold the rear door open for the person behind you when alighting.

## Student Bill of Rights...

***We, in Montgomery County Transit, are dedicated to excellence in mobility options.***

***As our riders, you have the right to:***

1. A safe and reliable bus ride.
2. Professional and courteous service.
3. A clean and comfortable bus.
4. Accurate information on routes, schedules, fares, and other mobility options.
5. Know the rules of riding the bus and have the rules posted in the vehicle.
6. Report the disputes over fares and transfers.
7. Know the bus number to report incidents or resolve problems.
8. Rider-to-rider courtesy encouraged by the bus operator.
9. Access to and receive a timely response from all levels of the organization.
10. Tell us about the quality of our service and how we can make our transit system better.
