Adopts the Long Branch "Earth Day" Creek Clean Up at the Long Branch Community Center and the Broad Acres "Earth Day" Park Clean Up at the Broad Acres School on April 18, 2009 as Silver Spring Citizens Advisory Board projects for 2009.
