2.69	16	There are no abandoned cars in the neighborhood.
2.91	14	There are no abandoned buildings in the neighborhood.
2.92	15	There are no vacant, unkempt lots in the neighborhood.
2.93	2	There are no houses or apartment buildings that are vacant
3.14	5	Parks and playgrounds are appealing
3.33	12	Neighborhood identification signs help reinforce the identity of the area.
3.56	8	Street surfaces in the neighborhood generally are in good repair.
3.67	18	There is no graffiti in the neighborhood.
3.76	7	The sidewalks in the neighborhood handle pedestrian activity adequately.
3.82	4	The maintenance of front and side yards including fences walkways and driveways appear satisfactory
3.89	3	There are no houses or apartments that are in need of major repairs
3.92	9	Parking in the neighborhood is satisfactory to meet the needs of residents and their visitors.
3.94	11	Street signs easily allow people to identify where they are.
3.98	1	The overall condition of the exterior of the houses/apt (structure, roof, windows, doors, porches, steps appears satisfactory
3.98	17	There is no evidence of illegal dumping in the area.
3.98	19	Overall visual attractiveness of the neighborhood is satisfactory or better.
3.99	13	Cleanliness of the neighborhood is generally satisfactory.
4.00	6	Businesses and storefront facades in the neighborhood generally are in satisfactory condition.

Average scores for each block (not including Question 6) range from 2.59 to 3.88
