



## Come splash with us again this summer of 2009!

The 2009 Summer Outdoor Pool Season will officially begin on Saturday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>. We invite you and your family to once again spend the summer at one of our County-operated outdoor pools. Enclosed is a summer application form for this summer's passes.

Again this year, we will run a pre-season schedule from May 23<sup>rd</sup> to June 14<sup>th</sup>. Our full season schedule will run from June 15<sup>th</sup> to August 23<sup>rd</sup>. The post season schedule will run from August 24<sup>th</sup> to September 7<sup>th</sup>. Please review specific hours and days of operation for each pool on the reverse side of this letter.

*Note: On two or three Wednesday evenings, in late June or July, the pool may close at 5:00 p.m. to host a swim meet. Please check the bulletin board regularly for program updates.*

The County Access Card (pool pass) that was issued last year will continue to be used. Each card holder will be responsible for their card; it will not be collected. Your Access Card does not need to be replaced each year. The card will be updated on the computer upon your renewal. **PLEASE NOTE THAT EACH PASSHOLDER MUST HAVE HER OR HIS OWN CARD SCANNED UPON EACH ENTRY TO THE FACILITY.** If a card holder does not have her/his card, she/he will be required to pay the admission fee. If a card is lost, the replacement fee of \$5.00 will be charged for **each** pass. All passes will expire on September 7, 2009. All summer pool passes are valid at all other County-operated **outdoor** pools. They are not valid at County-operated indoor pools.

To purchase your new pass, fill out the enclosed application form and choose one of the following:

1. Mail completed form (check payment only) to: Registrar, Montgomery County Recreation Department, 4010 Randolph Rd, Silver Spring, MD 20902 **before May 1, 2009.**
2. Take completed form to one of our four indoor facilities to process the application.
3. Take completed form to the outdoor pool, when open, to process the application. Be prepared to wait before entering the facility!
4. If you do not have an Access Card (pool pass); one will need to be made for each passholder. This can be done at any of our indoor facilities or the outdoor pools when open to the public. Access Cards can also be made at any County Community Center.

NOTE: Please keep your Access Cards. You will be charged the \$5.00 replacement fee next year if you lose them. These cards are the same cards used by other Recreation Department Programs.

***When completing your registration form, please be sure to provide us with an accurate e-mail address. Beginning next summer, pass applications will be available on-line or via e-mail. Pass applications will not be mailed for Summer 2010.***

### **Lesson Registration**

Lesson registration will, again, be available on-line. Montgomery County currently offers RecWeb internet registration at as convenient alternative to in-person registration. See the Recreation Guide for more information. All lesson registrations (in-person, on-line, mailed or faxed) for Montgomery County residents for the outdoor pools will begin June 1<sup>st</sup> at 6:30 a.m. Non-County Residents' lesson registration will begin June 2<sup>nd</sup> at 6:30 a.m.

The MCSL/MCRD Swim Team meetings for parents and swimmers will be on Tuesday, May 26<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. at the pool of your choice (rain or shine). MLK Outdoor Pool does not have a summer swim team.
