Executive Recommendation

The Executive recommends a total 6-year expenditure of \$840,000 to fund the Public Arts Trust (PAT) for the FY15-20 Capital Improvements Program. He recommends \$140,000 be appropriated in current revenue for the FY15 and FY16 Capital Budgets. The PAT PDF No. 729658 is attached at ©1.

The AHCMC materials are a thorough report on the activities of the Public Arts Trust. For the worksession, AHCMC CEO Suzan Jenkins will provide a brief oral report on the PAT and will be available to respond to Committee questions.

Public Arts Trust Program

The Public Arts Trust was established in 1995 to buy and display works of art on public property in the County and to sponsor privately-funded temporary or permanent displays of art on public property in the County. The Trust is established under County Code Chapter 8, Article VI, “Works of Art in Public Architecture”.

By law the CAO or a designee must administer the Trust in consultation with the AHCMC, MCPS, Montgomery College, and M-NCPPC. The CAO has designated the Department of Recreation as the County’s point of contact with the Public Arts Trust. The County contracts with the Arts and Humanities Council to manage the program.

§8-45: Each year the County Council should consider appropriating funds for the next fiscal year to the Public Arts Trust in an amount equal to .05% of the combined total approved programmed capital expenditures for the then current fiscal year for County Government, Public Schools, Montgomery College, and Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission.

This non-binding language is intended as a guideline for appropriations, and permits the Council to appropriate at a level other than the formula amount. The law says that each year the Council should consider funding the Public Arts Trust at the formula level. The PAT is funded with current revenue and the amount of funding has been adjusted each year according to affordability.

Budget Background and CE Recommendation

The approved FY10 Capital Budget included expenditures of \$140,000 for the PAT and for fiscal reasons, the PAT Capital Budget was suspended. The AHCMC agreed to the suspension due to the extreme and unusual fiscal situation with the understanding that the program would soon be restored and returned to level expenditures of \$140,000 per year. Restoration of some funding began in FY11.

For the FY15 and FY16 Capital Budgets, the Executive has recommended \$140,000 in current revenue for each year, restoring PAT expenditures to pre-recession funding levels.

Description

Effective April 12, 1995, the County Council enacted legislation providing for the creation of a Public Arts Trust. The purpose of this program is to incorporate art into public facilities and sponsor privately-funded temporary or permanent displays of art on public property. As written, the County Chief Administrative Officer [CAO] administers the trust in consultation with the Arts and Humanities Council of Montgomery County (AHCMC), Montgomery County Public Schools, Montgomery College, and the Montgomery County Parks Commission. The request for County funds for this project will be determined annually. The guidelines state that the annual request for the next fiscal year will be 0.05 percent of the total approved programmed capital expenditures for the current year Capital Improvements Program of the County Government, Public Schools, Montgomery College, and the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission. Each year, the County Council should consider appropriating this amount but may appropriate any amount.

Cost Change

Funding has been added for FY19 and FY20, partially offset by capitalization of prior year costs.

Justification

Bill 12-94, a revision to the Art in Public Architecture law, provides for the creation of a Public Arts Trust. The Public Arts Trust is administered by the County Chief Administrative Officer.

Fiscal Note

The Public Arts Trust is implemented through the Department of Recreation via an outside contract with the AHCMC.

Disclosures

Expenditures will continue indefinitely.

Thank you for the opportunity to highlight the contributions and activities of the Public Arts Trust (PAT), a program managed by the Arts and Humanities Council of Montgomery County (AHC/MC) under contract with the County Department of Recreation.

The mission of the Public Arts Trust is to build and inspire communities through creative place-making, to nurture artists engaged in public art, and care for the County's extensive collection of public art. Artwork under the jurisdiction of Trust may be found throughout the County - in schools, parks, plazas, libraries, and in office buildings like the EOB, the COB, the Judicial Center and Health and Human Services. The people of Montgomery County interact with the County's Public Art collection every day.

Among the County's notable works are sculptures and installations by world renowned artists such as Louise Nevelson, Martin Puryear, Jim Sanborn, Heidi Lippman, and Vicki Scuri, and many by significant regional artists, representing a rich cultural legacy that must be preserved for future generations. Through our recent work we have identified that there are 868 works of art in the Public Art Collection including 568 works on paper and 300 sculpture/murals.

Since 1995 when the law creating the Trust was enacted, the Public Arts Trust, in its current form, has been managed by the Arts and Humanities Council. Chapter 8 of the Montgomery County Code, Article VI, "Works of Art in Public Architecture," Section 8-45 states that, "Each year the County Council should consider appropriating funds for the next fiscal year to the Public Arts Trust in an amount equal to 0.05% of the combined total approved capital expenditures for the then-current fiscal year for County Government, Public Schools, Montgomery College and Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission."

The Public Arts Trust is currently guided by a Steering Committee (PATSC) comprised of private sector representatives with expertise in public art, representatives of government agencies including the Department of Recreation, the Department of Housing and Community Affairs, the Department of Public Works and Transportation, City of Gaithersburg, City of Rockville, Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, and community representatives. With diminished funding reinstated for FY12, FY13 and FY14, we have completed an inventory of County-owned public art; created a robust data base, and conserved and/or maintained 34% of the collection that has been evaluated as endangered or in fair or poor condition.

COLLECTION SURVEY AND FINDINGS

To date, we have catalogued and surveyed 257 public artworks owned by the County. These include sculptures, murals, and stained glass. Student interns and professional conservation technicians, under the supervision of Public Arts Trust Director, completed the survey between January 2012 and August 2013. The survey's primary aim was to confirm the location of artworks, determine the basic condition of all artworks, collect information, including digital photographs, and determine if maintenance has been regularly performed. **See attached AHCMC Survey Report, Attachment 1.** In addition to the survey of public artworks owned by the County, we have completed an inventory of the County's Works on Paper collection. We will continue efforts to track down missing works and create an online distribution system. **See attached Works on Paper Report, Attachment 2.**

The PAT oversees a diverse collection. Many of the works date to the early '90s and have never been maintained, conserved or treated. Condition of the pieces range from endangered to excellent. While some artworks don't require treatment by a specialist and can be assigned to a conservation technician or staff for minor treatments or annual cleaning, plans for the future include contracting conservation specialists to treat sub-groups of objects such as glazed ceramics, mosaics, wood, stained glass, and bronze. Once most objects are brought up to a state of good repair, maintenance should be performed regularly to protect the County's investment.

As a result of the survey, we have issued collection condition reports to the Dept. of General Services, Department of Recreation, the Montgomery Public Schools, and the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission to make staff aware of public art under their jurisdiction, encourage better communication with the PAT to protect artworks during facilities renovation, and to develop a plan for the long-term maintenance of the collection.

Survey Follow-up

- Additional research is required with regard to several pieces noted as missing. It is possible that these artworks have been put in storage, but this information was not available to the surveyor
- Identify projects which will require a specialist to treat and those that can be treated by either a conservation technician or County staff
- Begin implementation of a regular maintenance program for the collection

As a result of this work done by the PATSC and consultants over the past two years, we have developed a data base to manage all aspects of the collection, including curatorial information, current condition, and ownership responsibilities; created a partnership with Montgomery College and other area colleges and universities to implement an intern program to survey the current condition of the collection; computerized the survey form on portable tablets to allow for easy future surveys; hired conservators to provide condition assessments of most endangered artworks, perform conservation treatments.

FY 14 Conservation Plan

The FY14 budget of \$129,000 included funds for management, conservation and maintenance. The PAT was able to augment those funds with an additional \$50,000, provided by a private developer who has elected to contribute to fund projects under the PAT. Funds from the developer will be used to conserve and relocate *Gateway to the Mind* by Mary Ann Unger to the Germantown campus of Montgomery College - Attachment 5.

PUBLIC ARTS TRUST PROJECTS

Over the last several years, the PAT and AHCMC have established a closer working relationship with the Public Art Review Panel of the Planning Board so that the PAT may play a more active role in the review of public art commissioned by developers in exchange for increased density. Since 2012, representatives of the PAT have attended 12 meetings and reviewed 29 projects. In partnership with the Planning Board, we co-authored the new Montgomery County Public Art Guidelines, winner of the 2013 Gold MarCom Award in the category for Government Annual Reports for its design and writing. See Attachment 7.

PUBLIC ART ROAD MAP

As a follow-up to completion of the Montgomery County Public Art Guidelines, to better integrate the efforts of the Trust and the Planning Board and to take advantage of public art infrastructure and development

opportunities, we recommend the creation and adoption of a Montgomery County Public Art Road Map. This will be a collaborative effort to be undertaken by the Public Arts Trust, County Agencies, and the Planning Board.

Public art is most effective as a catalyst for city building, economic development, and beautification when it is integrated in its surrounding environment. Where it is located and how it connects to its surroundings and engages viewers can be as important as the design of the artwork itself. A Montgomery County Public Art Road Map will allow the County to better balance the efforts of the public and private sectors and guide private developers who sponsor public art, maximizing the benefits of public art for the public.

Though Montgomery County has long been a patron of public art, there has never been an articulated vision to guide the placement and type of projects across agencies. By adopting a County Public Art Road Map, it will be possible for the County to create a vision to leverage the most potential out of public art projects sponsored by both the County and private developers. Rather than reacting to individual projects submitted for review, with a Public Art Road Map, the Public Arts Trust would be in the driver's seat to steer projects where they would be most beneficial. In this way, public art could more effectively boost economic development, reinforce community identity, and enhance the daily lives of all of Montgomery County's residents.

A Public Art Road Map created as a joint effort of Montgomery County, the Planning Board, and the Public Arts Trust would:

- Allow the County to better integrate public art in infrastructure and street and open space projects at an early phase in design
- Provide a conceptual framework to contribute to the organization of open spaces, including parks, plazas, setbacks or streetscapes
- Identify areas where a more detailed public art plan should be developed
- Help raise the bar to identify the best artists and most creative ways to incorporate public art
- Show how to use public art to reinforce urban design objectives for the site, street or district as appropriate
- Ensure there will be a variety of public art types, opportunities and locations
- Promote responsiveness to various community needs and interests and
- Create links between public art projects and the County's larger objectives in the realm of public transportation, recreation, economic development, sustainability, and neighborhood improvement

As a collaborative project of County, Planning Board staff and the Public Arts Trust, the Public Art Road Map will provide a framework for integrating public art into all aspects of County development so that opportunities are not missed and the best public art projects can happen throughout the County. Public art should not be an afterthought or commissioned in a piecemeal fashion. A Road Map providing guidance for identifying prime locations, best practices, and areas under development, will yield the best results for County residents. It is a small investment that will have lasting impact.

In July of 2013 the Public Art Directory was launched on the AHCMC website with an initial group of 50 artworks. Featured works include a recorded description and an interview with the artist.

Having successfully authored a deaccession policy as part of the new public art guidelines, the PAT coordinated the sale of *Criss-Cross* by Albert Paley to a collector in Florida. With \$25,000 from the sale, supplemented with a \$5,000 grant from the Maryland State Council on the Arts originally earmarked for the reinstallation of Penguin Rush Hour at the Sarbanes Transit Center, we will coordinate and fund a \$30,000 replacement project in collaboration with stakeholders from Silver Spring, to be completed in FY15.

CREATIVE PLACEMAKING - Re-imagining the Holidays in Downtown Silver Spring

We have developed a public/private partnership with the Peterson Companies for the past two winter holiday seasons, to oversee the selection of an artist and creation of a public art holiday tree in Downtown Silver Spring.

The recent project, *Playtime Jubilee*, by Karl Unnasch was so successful it was featured on the *Today Show* and in the national art publication, *The Public Art Review*. Comprised of over 230 toys and play equipment, upon dismantling, all elements were donated to A Wider Circle for distribution to local children.

REQUEST FOR SUPPORT OF THE FY15/16 PAT CIP

Considering the initial \$4M investment made with taxpayer dollars into the collection, and, in order to maintain this asset for the citizens Montgomery County, ongoing funding is required for the management and conservation of the County's collection. In the last several years AHCMC has made tremendous progress in this regard, and we now have the collection management systems in place to deepen the effectiveness of our stewardship of the County's public art collection. As the old adage goes, "An Ounce of Prevention is Worth a Pound of Cure." Just as we expect developers to maintain public art on private property, we must set an example by maintaining and conserving the County's collection. Deteriorating artworks in schools and community centers sends a negative message to County residents and, of even greater concern is the danger deteriorating or poorly conserved artworks pose to public safety.

The FY15 and FY16 Public Art CIP # P729658 calls for \$50,000 for *Planning, Design and Supervision* and \$90,000 for *Other* which has been used previously for maintenance and conservation for a total of \$140,000 per year. Ongoing plans include the continued conservation and maintenance of the collection as articulated in the Summary of Findings from the recent survey of the collection.

As a result, the Arts and Humanities Council of Montgomery County respectfully requests that the County Council support the County Executive's Recommended FY15 and FY16 Budget Appropriation for the Public Arts Trust of \$140,000 per year and the extension of funding under this CIP through FY20.




These policies and procedures establish the guidelines for implementing the County's 1995 restoration of the public art program as per Chapter 8 of the Montgomery County Code, Article VI. Works of Art in Public Architecture, Sections 8-43 to 8-45 and Chapter 59 of the Montgomery County Zoning Ordinance.

This document was adopted by the Planning Board on December 13, 2012 as the Public Arts Trust Policies and Procedures but is now being officially referred to as Montgomery County Public Art Guidelines.
