SUBJECT: Update: Crime Statistics

Today the Committee will receive an update on current crime statistics in the County. Those expected to brief the Committee include Assistant Chief Russ Hamill and other Executive staff who can address staffing patterns and crime hot spots.

Crime statistics for the past three year full calendar years (2011-2013) as well as year-todate data for 2014 are attached at ©1-6. Council staff has also asked the Department for information on current crime trends, and how the implementation of the Department's staffing plan over the past several years has impacted crime. The Department will provide that information at today's worksession.

DISCUSSION ISSUES

1) How has the implementation of the first two years of the three-year staffing plan impacted crime, if at all?

2) The FY13 portion of the staffing plan included adding one District Community Action Team (DCAT) to each of the six police districts. The FY14 portion of the staffing plan added officers to target specific hot spots. What impact have these additions had on crime in general and the targeted hot spots in particular? Is crime being suppressed in the hotspots? Is there evidence it may have moved elsewhere?

3) Has increased investigative staff helped with closure rates?

4) What is the timeframe for fully implementing the FY15 staffing initiatives?




