**SUBJECT:** **Follow Up to Office of Legislative Oversight Report 2015-5: *Parking Lot District Fiscal Management and Budgeting***

On February 5, the Transportation, Infrastructure, Energy & Environment (T&E) Committee received a presentation on Office of Legislative Oversight Report 2015-5, *Parking Lot District Fiscal Management and Budgeting*. At the February T&E meeting, Acting DOT Director Al Roshdieh informed that the Executive would soon be prepared to respond to the findings and recommendation of the OLO report.

On March 16, the County Executive will transmit to Council his Recommended FY16 Operating Budget. Acting Director Roshdieh has notified staff that the Executive's budget recommendation will address Parking Lot District (PLD) fiscal management issues identified in the OLO report. Mr. Roshdieh will present the Executive's plan for the PLDs at the March 18 meeting of the T&E Committee. Specifically, staff has requested that Mr. Roshdieh address how the Executive's recommendations would:

- restore long-term fiscal stability to all four PLD enterprise funds;
- clarify the relationship between PLD resources and funding of non-parking activities (such as the urban districts and the Mass Transit Fund); and
- take into account the effect of Zoning Ordinance parking requirements on PLD property tax exemptions and revenue generation.
