
HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION
FORMERLY THE HUMAN RELATIONS COMMISSION

- Created -- Montgomery County Code Section 27-2. Bill No. 36-99, effective 8/13/2001 changed the name to Human Rights Commission and removed panels. Case Review Boards are to be appointed by and with Commission members.
- Purpose -- Initiate or receive and investigate complaints of discrimination against any person; study and investigate by means of public hearings, or otherwise any conditions having an adverse effect on intergroup relations; institute and conduct educational and other programs to promote equal rights for all persons; render not less than once a year a written report of activities and recommendations to the County Executive; recommend such legislation as deemed necessary to promote and insure equal rights and opportunities for all persons; and adopt such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out purposes and provisions of said ordinance.
- Membership -- 15 Commissioners who may also serve on Case Review Boards.
- Officers -- Commission must recommend individuals for chair to CE. After considering recommendations, CE must designate a member as chair. The Commission may elect other officers as it deems necessary.
- Financial Disclosure -- Confidential disclosure required.
- Terms -- Three-year terms - no compensation.
- Meetings -- Fourth Monday of each month.

Leggett Seeks Applicants for Human Rights Commission

County Executive Isiah Leggett is seeking applicants to fill five vacancies on the Montgomery County Human Rights Commission. Four of the incumbent members are eligible to apply for reappointment.

The 15-member commission promotes equal rights and opportunities for all persons. Commissioners are expected to serve on special or standing committees and participate in activities requiring involvement in the community. Commissioners serve on case review boards consisting of three individuals that consider and decide each complaint that the Director certifies to the Commission.

Regular meetings are held the fourth Monday evening of each month in Rockville. Members serve 3 year terms without compensation. Appointed members are required to file a confidential financial disclosure statement within fifteen days of Council confirmation and annually thereafter.

Applicants of diverse backgrounds, professions, gender, geography, disability and ethnicity are encouraged to apply, and should write by September 19 to County Executive Isiah Leggett at the Executive Office Building, 101 Monroe St., Rockville, MD 20850 or send an e-mail to countyexecutive.boards@montgomerycountymd.gov. A brief resume, including home and work phone numbers, should be included.

Members of County boards, committees and commissions may not serve on more than one such group at a time. Members of this committee are eligible for reimbursement for travel and dependent care for meetings attended. Leggett's appointments are subject to confirmation by the County Council. Applications of those selected for appointment are made public as part of the confirmation process.
