SUBJECT: Action to Extend Time for Consideration of proposed Executive Regulation 25-05, Disruptive Behavior - Recreation Programs

Background


1. On April 10, 2006, the County Council received proposed Executive Regulation 25-05, Disruptive Behavior - Recreation Programs. The Council must review the regulation under Method (2) of Section 2A-15 of the Montgomery County Code.
2. Under Method (2), if the Council does not approve or disapprove a regulation within 60 calendar days after the Council receives the regulation, the regulation automatically takes effect. The Council may extend the deadline by resolution.
3. The Council has determined that additional time is needed to consider this regulation.

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:

The time for consideration of proposed Executive Regulation 25-05, Disruptive Behavior - Recreation Programs, is extended to August 1, 2006.
