SUBJECT: Resolution to Approve a Modification to an Approved Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development Community Legacy Project

Background

- 1. The County Executive and the Council of Montgomery County, Maryland, recognize that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization of the community of segments of Silver Spring.
- 2. The Unitarian Universalist Affordable Housing Corporation a Community Development Financial Institution (CDFI), which will soon merge into the Washington Area Housing Trust Fund and be named the Open Door Housing Fund, proposes to utilize approved Community Legacy funding in the approved Wheaton, Long Branch, Silver Spring Community Legacy Area. The purpose of which will be to contribute to the reinvestment and revitalization in the Area.
- 3. The Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development (the "Department"), either through the Community Legacy Program or through other Programs of the Department, or in cooperation with other state departments or agencies, may provide some or all of the financing for the Project (the "Project Financing") in order to assist in making it financially feasible.
- 4. The Project Area is located within a Priority Funding Area under Section 5-7B-02 of the Smart Growth Act and the Project will conform to the local zoning code.
- 5. The applicable laws, regulations, and Departmental requirements necessitate approval of the Community Legacy Area designation, the Project, and the Project Financing by the Montgomery County Council and by the County Executive.
