## **Background**

- 1. Section 305 of the County Charter requires the affirmative vote of at least 7 Council members to approve the aggregate capital budget if that budget exceeds the adopted spending affordability guidelines then in effect.
- 2. Section 20-56 of the County Code requires the Council to set guidelines for County general obligation bonds by resolution no later than the first Tuesday in October in each odd-numbered calendar year. This section also permits the Council to revise the guidelines to reflect a significant change in conditions. The deadline for revision is the first Tuesday in February.
- 3. On October 6, 2009, the Council adopted guidelines for County general obligation bonds allowing no more than \$325 million to be planned for expenditure in FY 2011, no more than \$325 million to be planned for expenditure in FY 2012, and no more than \$1,950 million to be planned for expenditure over the 6-year period from FY 2011 through FY 2016.
- 4. On February 2, 2010, the Council confirmed the guidelines adopted on October 6, 2009.

## Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:

For County general obligation bonds, the Council estimates that the amount planned for expenditure is less than the guidelines. Because these guidelines are not exceeded, 7 affirmative votes are not required for approval of the aggregate capital budget.
