SUBJECT: Extension of Time for Council Action on Resolution to Adopt Board of Health Regulation Requiring a Health Impact Assessment for Major Road Projects

Background

1. Rule 7(e) of the Council's Rules of Procedure requires that a resolution will expire on the next August 31 after it is introduced, unless the Council adopts or defeats it sooner or by motion extends it to a specified date.
2. On July 27, 2010, the Council extended until December 31, 2010, a resolution to adopt Board of Health Regulation requiring a health impact assessment for major road projects. No consideration of the resolution has occurred since that time, and there has been a request by sponsors for another extension.


Action
