SUBJECT: Extension of Time to Consider Collective Bargaining Agreements

Background


1. On April 4, 2012, the County Executive submitted to the Council a collective bargaining agreement between the County government and Municipal and County Government Employees Organization to amend the existing collective bargaining agreement effective July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2015. On April 4, 2012, the County Executive submitted to the Council a collective bargaining agreement between the County government and Fraternal Order of Police to amend the existing collective bargaining agreement effective July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2014. On April 4, 2012, the County Executive submitted to the Council a new collective bargaining agreement between the County government and the International Association of Fire Fighters to amend the existing collective bargaining agreement effective July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013. Each memorandum specified the terms and conditions of the collective bargaining agreement amendments that require or may require an appropriation of funds or changes in any County law or regulation. Each of these collective bargaining agreements was negotiated between the parties.
2. Under County Code §§33-108, 33-80, and 33-153, the County Council is required to indicate on or before May 1 its intention regarding the appropriation of funds or any legislation or regulations required to implement these agreements.
3. County Code §§33-108(i), 33-80(h), and 33-153(o) allow the Council by majority vote to defer to any date not later than May 15, the deadline to indicate its intention regarding the appropriation of funds or other actions to implement these agreements.

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following resolution:

The Council defers to May 15, 2012, the deadline to indicate its intention regarding the appropriation of funds or any legislation or regulations required to implement the collective bargaining agreements with Municipal and County Government Employees Organization, Fraternal Order of Police, and International Association of Firefighters.
