SUBJECT: 90-day Extension of Temporary Executive Regulation 10-13T, Water Quality Protection Charge


Background

1. Section 19-35 of the County Code requires the County Executive to adopt regulations for the purpose of implementing the County's Water Quality Protection Charge under Chapter 19.
2. On April 25, 2013, the County Executive transmitted Executive Regulation 17-12AM, Water Quality Protection Charge, to the County Council.
3. On April 30, 2013, the County Council approved Executive Regulation 17-12AM, Water Quality Protection Charge.
4. On June 21, 2013, the Executive transmitted Temporary Executive Regulation 10-13T in order to clarify residential property hardship waiver eligibility, to note that certain property owners may apply to the Director of the Department of Environmental Protection to consolidate under a single parcel any contiguous parcels owned by the same owner, and to clarify that property owners may be eligible for partial credits for partial treatment of stormwater on a property.
5. On September 16, 2013, the Executive transmitted a request for a 90-day extension of Temporary Executive Regulation 10-13T.

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the Executive's request to extend Temporary Executive Regulation 10-13T by 90 days to December 18, 2013.
