# THE LIFE OF A TRANSPORTATION PROJECT

FACILITY PLANNING - PHASE I FACILITY PLANNING - PHASE II	Collect data, obtain public input, develop concept plans, evaluate and select preferred alignment/cross section.	
	Obtain approvals from Director and Montgomery County Council Transportation Infrastructure, Energy and Environment Committee (T&E).	
	Develop preliminary (35% level of completion) design plans, cost estimates and project schedule.	
	Submit to County Executive and County Council for final decision on final design and construction funding in Capital Improvement Program (CIP).	
FINAL DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION	If approved for full funding and is included in CIP, complete final design and construction.

- » Improve safety of bicycling on MacArthur Boulevard to better serve the bicyclists of all ages and abilities










