Summary: This regulation amends the civil penalty for violation of § 21-706.1 of the Transportation Article in compliance with the state law and decision of the Chief Judge of the District Court of Maryland.

Background: § 21-706.1 of the Transportation Article allows for a local jurisdiction to have a School Bus Safety Camera program so long as there is enacting legislation at the local level. Montgomery County Code Chapter 31, Section 9 B authorizes a School Bus Safety Camera program and further provides that the civil penalty be up to a maximum of \$250. The Chief Judge of the District Court sets the civil penalty to be reflected on the uniform civil citation.

COMCOR 31.09B.01 School Bus Safety Cameras

31.09B.01.01 Purpose

The purpose of this regulation is to establish civil penalties in accordance with § 21-706.1 of the Transportation Article.

31.09B.01.02 Civil Penalty

The civil penalty to be imposed for a violation of § 21-706.1 of the Transportation Article is \$250 to conform with the decision of the Chief Judge of the District Court of Maryland.
