

Background: Montgomery County Code, 2004, as amended, Section 48-26, provides that the County Executive must establish by executive regulation the annual amount of permit and license fees. The \$25.00 fee for licensing is based on an historical fee. The fee covers basic review and processing of the solid waste collector/ hauler application as well as the issuance of a license for each individual company. While the fee does not cover the entire allocated amount of the licensing process, it does cover the preliminary review cost associated with the issuance of a solid waste collector/hauler license. The \$5.00 vehicle permit fee is designed to cover the fixed direct cost of the metal plates and the issuance of the decals for the plates.

Section 1. Montgomery County Code, 2004, as amended, Section 48-26 specifies that: "Permit or license fees under this chapter shall be fixed annually by executive regulation adopted by the County Executive under Method (3) of section 2A-15 of this Code. The fees shall not exceed the cost of inspection, licensing, and enforcement of this chapter." The annual licensing fees for a company whose principal business is the collection or hauling of solid waste is \$25.00, and the permitting fee for each commercial vehicle is \$5.00.

Background: Montgomery County Code, 2004, as amended, Section 48-26, provides that the County Executive must establish by executive regulation the annual amount of permit and license fees. The \$25.00 fee for licensing is based on an historical fee. The fee covers basic review and processing of the solid waste collector/ hauler application as well as the issuance of a license for each individual company. While the fee does not cover the entire allocated amount of the licensing process, it does cover the preliminary review cost associated with the issuance of a solid waste collector/hauler license. The \$5.00 vehicle permit fee is designed to cover the fixed direct cost of the metal plates and the issuance of the decals for the plates.

Section 1. Montgomery County Code, 2004, as amended, Section 48-26 [of the Montgomery County Code] specifies that: "Permit or license fees under this chapter shall be fixed annually by executive regulation adopted by the County Executive under Method (3) of section 2A-15 of this Code. The fees shall not exceed the cost of inspection, licensing, and enforcement of this chapter." The annual licensing fees for a company whose principal business is the collection or hauling of solid waste is \$25.00, and the permitting fee for each commercial vehicle is \$5.00.
