Monday was an active day – please see the summary below

Fleet

Apparatus / Fleet – 3 units sustained damage from snow chains, low hanging wires or snow banks. All units remained in-service.

Calls

Call volume remained 50% higher than a regular day. About total of 470 calls dispatched in 24 hours compared to a baseline normal of ~ 300 calls. The majority of the increase was in medical events – roughly evenly distributed between ALS and BLS.

For structural collapse - we had the significant church collapse on New Hampshire along with 2 or 3 minor events.

Only two (2) dispatched pedestrian's struck.

We experienced the anticipated uptick in service calls for water infusion in structures – mainly from broken water pipes and water leaking in from roof/ice problems.

Fire's

One house fire – Takoma Park on Kingwood Drive([CLICK HERE](#)) – units arrived with fire showing - caused by un-attended candle – damage of \$ 75,000.00 total.

Personnel

No reported on-duty injuries

Preparations for Tuesday

Same enhancements carried over from Monday - FRS additional EMS units staffed, along with 3 engines upgraded to paramedic engine, light duty utilities/plows, DOT plow liaisons, mechanic/fleet, and support personnel. We plan to carry these enhancements to 1700 hours on Wednesday and will re-assess mid-day tomorrow.

Apparatus / Fleet – 6 to 10 units sustained damage from getting stuck in the snow and/or chain malfunctions All appear to remain in-service.

Calls

Call volume was just ~ 15% higher than a regular day. About total of 325 calls dispatched in 24 hours

Several non-residential roof/structural issues (collapses). One significant collapse of a large barn off of Partnership Road. FRS supported farmer with structural assessment and then enabling the animals trapped inside to get out. Roughly 12 horses rescued and 2 or 3 with minor injuries.(CLICK HERE FOR TWEET)

Activity level remained very high on Tuesday – please see the summary below

Fleet

Apparatus / Fleet – 1 unit sustained damage from snow chains, low hanging wires or snow banks. Two other apparatus damage due to high call load and all 3 units remained in-service.

Calls

Call volume is starting to return to normal – Tuesday was 30% higher than a regular day – down from 50% on Monday.

About total of 380 calls dispatched in 24 hours compared to a baseline normal of ~ 300 calls. The majority of the increase was in medical events – roughly evenly distributed between ALS and BLS.

For structural collapse - we only had 1 event – a deck collapse at a townhouse off of Tuckerman Lane. Pedestrian's struck only accounted for 3 events.

Two (2) reported on-duty injuries

Same enhancements carried over from Monday and Tuesday - FRS additional EMS units staffed, along with 3 engines upgraded to paramedic engine, light duty utilities/plows, DOT plow liaisons, mechanic/fleet, and support personnel.
