SUBJECT: 2006 General Elections

General Election Day is Tuesday November 7, 2006. Personnel who are working 12 or 24 hours on that day and who wish to vote will be provided a maximum of three hours of Administrative Leave (AML) at the beginning of the shift if the requirements below are satisfied.

- Personnel who wish to vote must email #FRS.Schedulers expressing their intention *not later than 1700 hours on Friday November 3rd*.
- On Election Day, personnel who have made plans to vote must report to their polling place not later than 0700 hours, vote, and obtain a certificate of participation, or other proof of having voted.
- After voting, personnel must report directly to their assigned work site, as designated by Telestaff.
- Personnel must present proof of having voted to their Battalion Chief.
