



SUBJECT: Driver Certifications

Effective this date, all employees of the Department are required to provide the DFRS Duty Chief's Office at Station 20 with driver and personnel information as changes occur. A copy of an update form is attached.

When driver certifications are made, the senior career officer must validate completion of the appropriate training and checkout. These certifications must meet the requirements of the county-wide driver training program currently being finalized by the Fire and Rescue Commission titled Driver Certification Policy.

Additionally, Department employees are required to advise the Department, through the chain of command, when they receive a traffic violation, driver license suspension/revocation, class of license change or change in state registration.

Completion of this form for other personnel matters does not provide notification to the County's Office of Personnel. The specific forms used by the Office of Personnel must also be completed and forwarded to the appropriate office.

This Directive replaces Directive Number 91-16, which should be destroyed.
