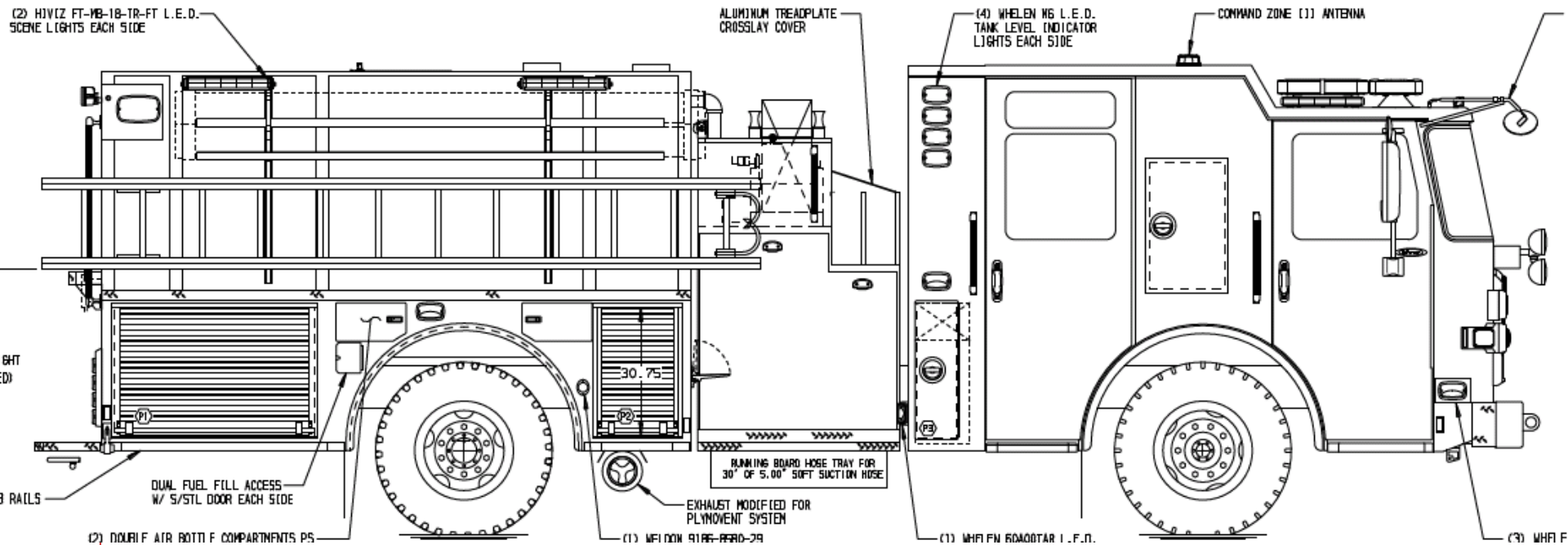

Pierce Engine

- Pierce Enforcer (96" wide) cab & chassis w/ seating for 5
- Easy clean / decon cab
- Exposed curb side ladders
- LED scene lighting.
- Siren speaker mounted at the rear of the vehicle.
- Hale Qmax 1500 GPM pump
- 750 gallons water & 50 gallons of class "A" foam





Pierce Engine

- Class "B" foam portable (pails/inductor/nozzle)
- Trident priming system.
- Same hose capacity
- 2 crosslays / 4 rear pre-connects / supply
- Booster reel - 200-ft. 1".
- Shorter ~ OAL 3' +
- Lower ~ hose bed 1' - 5'4" ground to hose bed

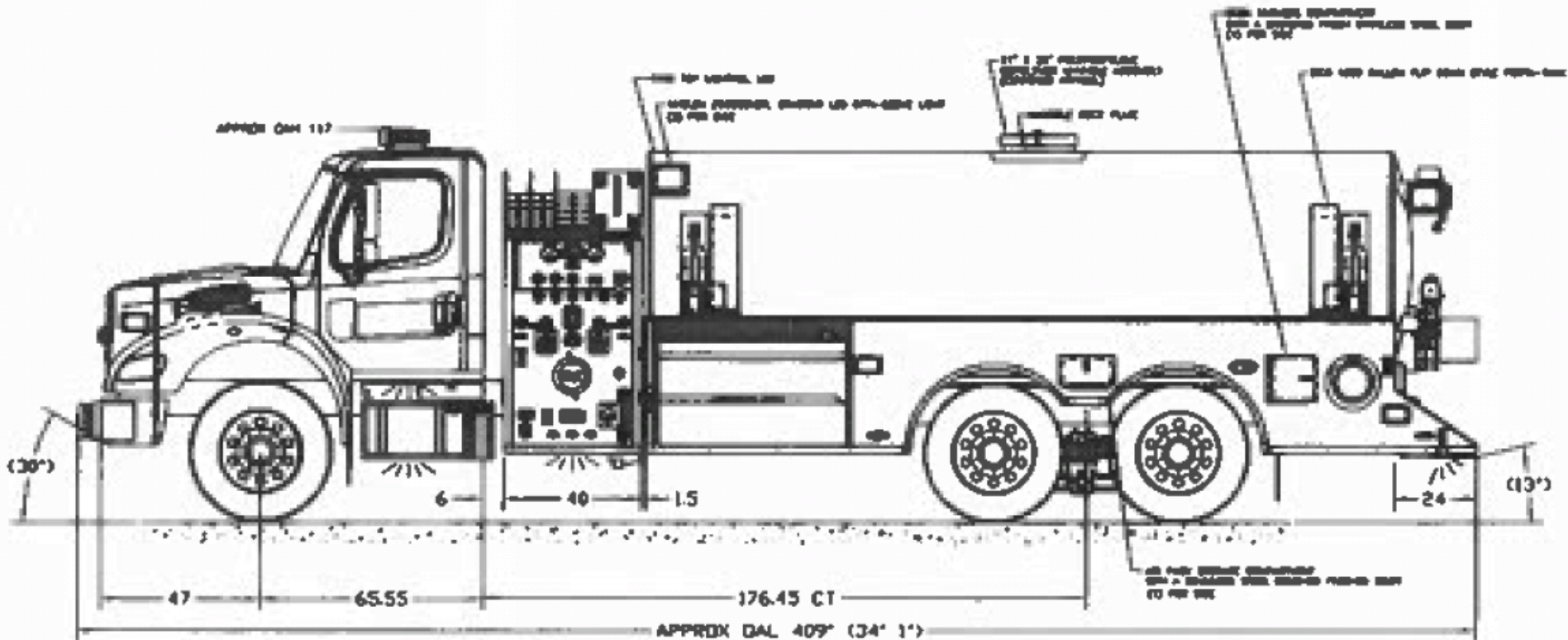
- # 1 – here July 2018

Tankers

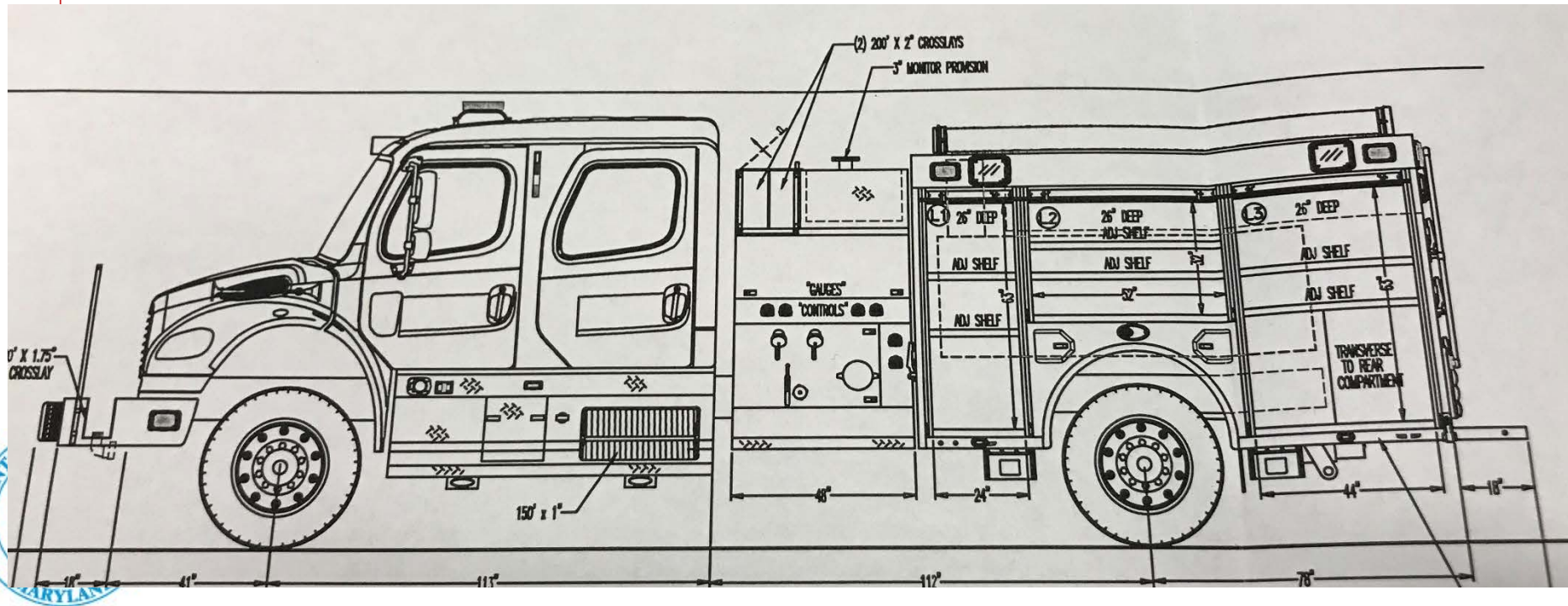
- US Tanker

All-Wheel Drive

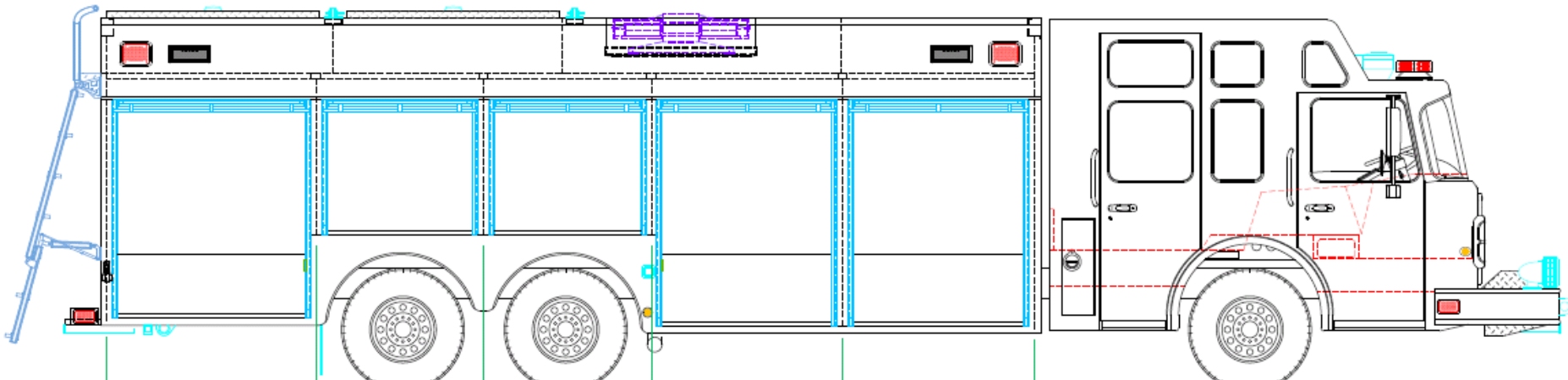
- Rosenbauer

Technical Operations

- TechOps just completed a complete refurbishment of all APX > XE (Firefighter Style) Radios. This style radio in the fleet has all been completely rebuilt and recertified by Motorola.
- Chief Officers will soon be getting APX8000 All Band Radios. These will be in addition to the APX7000 that you already have and we will recall your older XTS (Yellow) radio
- Please make sure that Chief Officers with AEDs get to the recalibration/service sessions when they are scheduled. We will do this at least once, likely twice per year and we need to touch all devices.
