SUBJECT: Modification to Policy and Procedure # 529 "Internal Affairs"

To ensure that DFRS personnel assigned as an Internal Affairs Investigator are not placed in a position of working with other personnel that are currently under investigation by Internal Affairs, I am modifying DFRS Policy and Procedure #529, "Internal Affairs" as follows.

Add:

4.11 DFRS will not detail or assign a current Internal Affairs Investigator to the same shift and location where a DFRS employee who is under investigation is currently assigned.

Change:

5.5 Internal Affairs Investigator

a. The Internal Affairs Investigator is responsible for ensuring a complete and expeditious investigation of all cases referred to the Internal Affairs Section. The Internal Affairs Investigator must apprise and update the Fire Administrator of all Internal Affairs investigations.

b. The DFRS employee assigned as the Internal Affairs Investigator must advise the respective bureau scheduler if a detail or assignment would place them working on the same shift and location as someone that is currently under investigation.

All station commanders and DFRS policy manual holders are to place a copy of this Directive with policy # 529.
