SUBJECT: October Breast Cancer Awareness Month



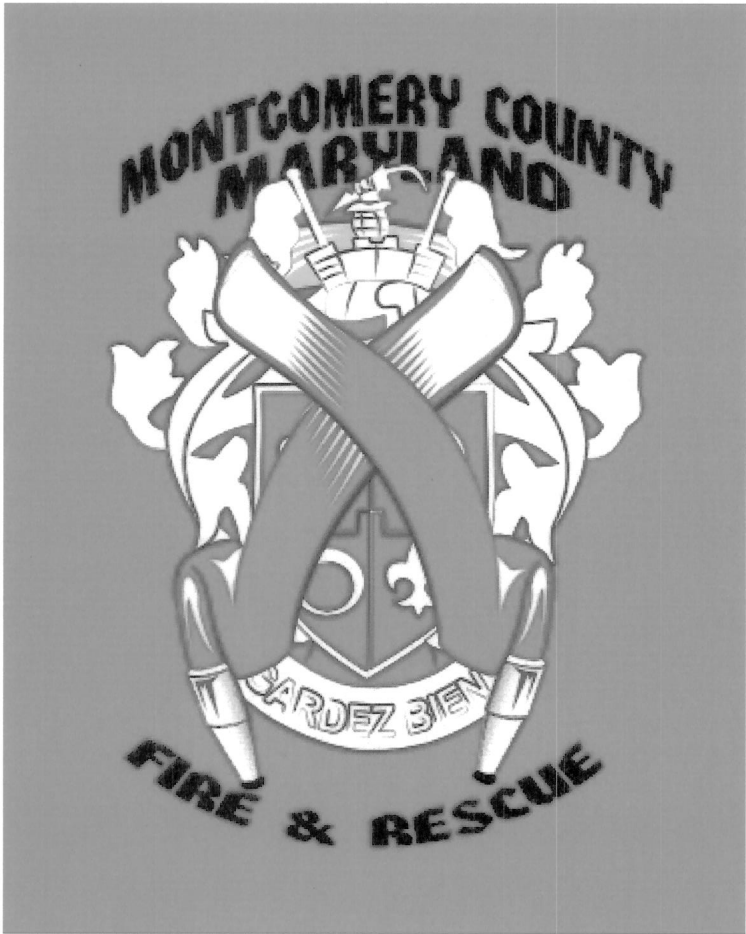
October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month. In cooperation with the International Association of Fire Fighters Local 1664, the Fire Chief has again agreed to allow MCFRS personnel to wear the approved "Cancer Awareness" pink apparel. Approved pink apparel for the 2012 campaign includes, short sleeve t-shirts; long sleeve t-shirts and sweatshirts with the approved logo, (illustrated in the attachment) and baseball style hats, while on-duty.

The pink tee-shirts, sweatshirts and baseball style hats will be considered optional apparel, and may be purchased by the employee at their own expense. The tee-shirts and sweatshirts may be worn in-place of the Class "C" uniform shirt-from October 1st through October 31st, 2012, in support of Breast Cancer Awareness Month.
