On Sunday, December 4, 2016, The Montgomery County Office of Human Rights (OHR) will host its Ninth Human Rights Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony at the BlackRock Center for the Arts in Germantown, Maryland. The Human Rights Hall of Fame mission is to honor individuals who have made great personal sacrifices in contributing to human and civil rights in Montgomery County, either as trailblazers of the past or as current light bearers in the struggle.

Selection criteria for Hall of Fame members, living or deceased should include examples of visionary leadership, notable achievements, and efforts to diminish the effects of discrimination and advancing human rights.

Nomination Procedures

To nominate an individual for the Hall of Fame:

- Complete Nomination Form and Print and Mail to the address below
- Include a narrative (typed, single spaced, 12 point font) containing a concise overview supporting the nomination which documents your nominee's achievement(s), accomplishment(s) and contribution(s) to human and civil rights in Montgomery County and how the nominees' attributes have advanced human and civil rights in the county
- You may provide supplemental information that will further demonstrate the contribution of the individual.

The narrative including any supplemental materials must not exceed three pages.

*Hall of Fame inductees are nominated by the community and selected by a panel of Human Rights Hall of Fame members and current Montgomery County Human Rights Commissioners. Current staff members of the Montgomery County Office of Human Rights may not be considered and do not participate in the selection process.
