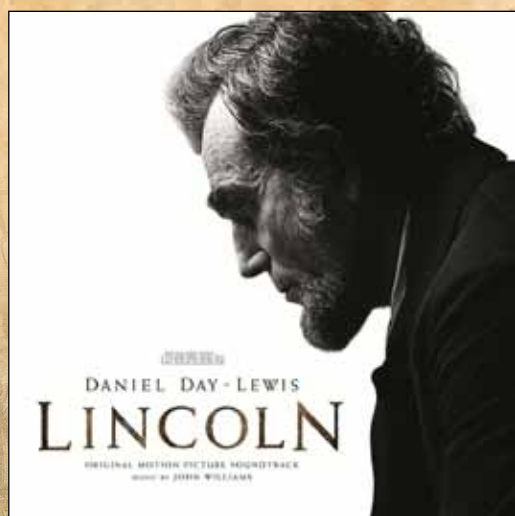

An American epic historical drama film based in part on Doris Kearns Goodwin's biography *Team of Rivals: The Political Genius of Abraham Lincoln*, and covers the final four months of Lincoln's life, focusing on the President's efforts in January 1865 to have the Thirteenth Amendment to the United States Constitution passed by the United States House of Representatives.

In December 2012, the film was nominated for seven Golden Globe Awards including Best Motion Picture – Drama, Best Director for Spielberg and winning Best Actor (Motion Picture – Drama), Best Supporting Actor and Best Supporting Actress. In 2013, at the 85th Academy Awards, the film was nominated for twelve Academy Awards including Best Picture; it won for Best Production Design and Best Actor for Daniel Day-Lewis.
