<u>202 – Computer Connectivity Requirements, Policy No. 01-09.</u> The Fire Chief recommended to the Fire and Emergency Services Commission to repeal existing policy No. 01-09, Computer Connectivity Requirements. This policy was implemented in July 2004, and is out dated and does not apply to today's IT standards. Commissioner Ford inquired what policy was replacing this document. Staff advised that there are current County IT Policies in effect that address all the MCFRS IT Standards.
