101- Election of Chair and Vice Chair of the Commission

He also reported on the current status of the Coronavirus delta variant in MCFRS and the line-of-duty death of Captain Laird of Frederick County Fire and Rescue Service. The Montgomery County Fair starts on Friday August 13th. The MCFRS FY22 Budget submission is on-going. The Chief announced that he will be entering the 3 year drop retirement program and will be retiring from MCFRS in 2024.
