PROJECT DESCRIPTION

In partnership with M-NCPPC Parks, the County is proposing to build a new Neighborhood Recreation Center, new parking area, demolish the existing building, and various park improvement.

- Demolition of existing building.
- New Construction consists of a gymnasium, fitness area, multipurpose activity rooms / social hall with kitchenette.
- A key constraint is the limit on impervious site area, due to the Paint Branch Special Protection Area, resulting in expansion requirements that do not increase the building footprint.
- The project will be designed to comply with Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) guidelines for LEED Silver certification.
- The project preliminary design phase is complete.
