All teams practice once a week (weekdays only). This league does not accept individual "free agent" players. ✓ Coaches may submit a team roster, but each player must complete an individual registration form. ✓ 4th graders are permitted to participate in the 5th grade league; ✓ Teams play ten (10) games within an 8 week season.

All Coaches must be fingerprinted by Montgomery County Recreation. Your League Director will help set up an appointment for fingerprinting. ▪ A Coaches meeting is scheduled for <u>Tuesday November 18th</u> (policies and procedures) at the Recreation Department Theatre and at the Germantown Community Center. Coaches should plan to attend the meeting at one of the locations. ▪ Free Coaches clinics to be held (skill building) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Thursday Nov 20th 7-9 pm at Potomac Community Center – all levels Saturday, Dec 6th 10-12pm at Mid County Community Center – all levels Monday, Dec 15th 7-9pm at Mid County Community Center – for K-2 coaches only
<p>Officials/staff needed</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Individuals, at least 16 years old, are needed to officiate games in the 3rd – 5th grades; Saturday and/or Sunday hours. ▪ Salary is determined by previous referee experience and education. Officiating instruction is provided in late November and early December, plus on the job mentoring will be provided. ▪ Gym staff is needed to work game days for grades 3rd – 12th; Saturday and/or Sunday hours. ▪ All interested must apply through IRecruit at www.montgomerycountymd.gov/careers ▪ Sports score keeper S2 – IRC14178 ▪ Gym/ Field supervisor S5 – IRC14176 ▪ Contact the League Director in your area for more information.
