Thank you for your April 5, 2014, letter encouraging coordination with the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) on their DC Streetcar planning and transit in Silver Spring. I agree that a collaborative effort with the District is an important step in providing high quality, seamless transit in the region.

I am pleased to report that the Montgomery County Department of Transportation (MCDOT) has been actively following the DC Streetcar planning studies and DDOT representatives recently presented their planning study to the Rapid Transit Steering Committee. As your letter noted, the District North-South Planning Study is looking at corridor terminus either at Takoma Metrorail station or in Silver Spring. I believe that everyone agrees that Silver Spring is the preferred terminus for the DC Streetcar. MCDOT, along with the Maryland Transit Administration will continue to monitor the District study and will work with them to explore opportunities to study bringing the DC Streetcar to Silver Spring.

I appreciate all of the hard work of the Silver Spring Citizens Advisory Board and will ask MCDOT Director Holmes to keep you informed on our coordination progress. Thank you again for writing.
