Upcounty Faith Community Meets with New County Liaison



Child Safety Seat Inspection

Get free checks of the condition and proper installation of child safety seats by nationally-certified car seat technicians from Fire & Rescue personnel, Police, and Fitzgerald's staff. Maryland law mandates that every child under eight years old must be secured in a federally-approved and correctly used child restraint system (child safety seat or booster seat) when riding in a motor vehicle, unless the child is 4'9" or taller, or weighs more than 65 pounds. All vehicle passengers under the age of 16 must be restrained by a seat belt.
