
The Census Bureau is looking for qualified applicants in Montgomery County and the District of Columbia!



The U.S. Census Bureau is researching modern and new methods for the population to make sure they are counted in the next census. This effort includes the 2014 Census Test that will allow the Bureau to try a variety of new methods and advance technologies that are under consideration for the 2020 Census.

The 2014 Test will take place from June 23, through September 25, with Census Day taking place on July 1, 2014. The test will be conducted in portions of Washington D.C., and Montgomery County, MD. The Census Bureau will open a temporary Local Census Office (LCO) in Silver Spring, MD to conduct the 2014 Census Test and is hiring field staff for temporary positions. Pay ranges from \$14-\$21.50 an hour. Be a part of helping to shape the 2020 Census! They need to hire 1,000 people!
